in Belgium for a very timely which coincided with the Centenary celebrations. It was a massive success and provided many opportunity to contemplate and remember.



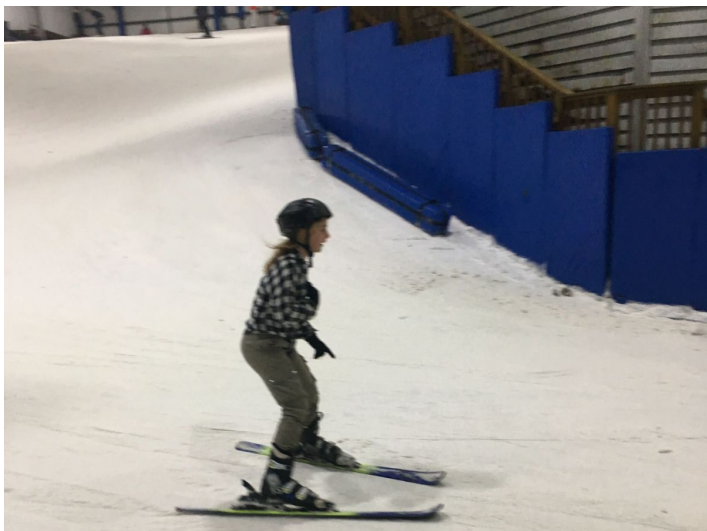

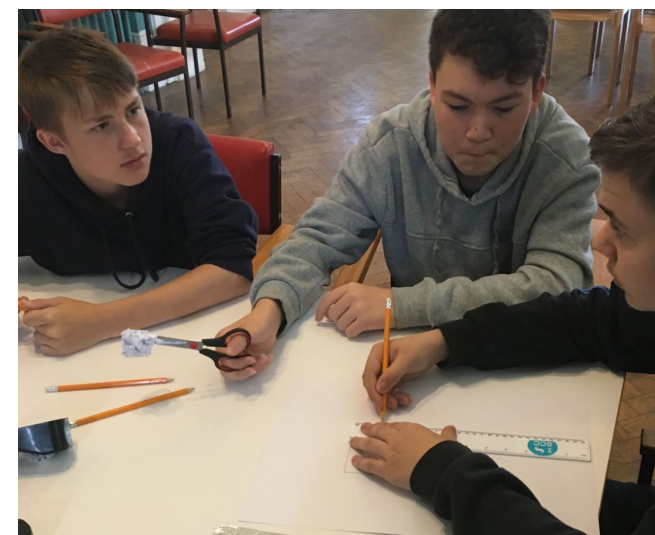
