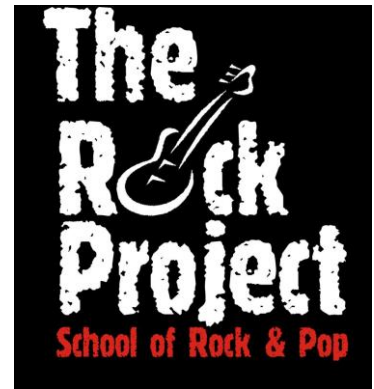


# THE ROCK PROJECT GLOUCESTER 2017



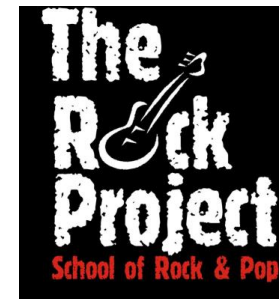
## - Information -

The Rock Project is the premier school for children's contemporary music tuition in the British Isles ([www.therockproject.com](http://www.therockproject.com)). We offer group lessons in electric guitar, bass guitar, drums and vocals and the opportunity for young people aged 7-18 years old to put their musical skills into practice by performing regularly each week as part of a band. At the end of the year we put on a large concert for students to perform to friends, family and the general public.

Founded in Denbigh, North Wales in 2005 there are now over 60 schools nationwide with more schools opening all the time! All tuition is carried out by professional musicians who are all DBS checked.

In Gloucestershire we have two schools operating in Cheltenham (St. Pauls Old School, Cleeve School), with a third opening in May. Now we are looking for venues in which to open schools in, and around, Gloucester.





# Venue Info

To run a successful Rock Project school, a large room for band practice and 4 smaller tuition rooms are required between the hours of 4pm and 9pm.

Sessions run from 4.30pm until 8.30pm, the first 2 hours being a junior session (7-11 yr olds), the second 2 hours being a senior session (12-18 yr olds).

We teach drums, electric guitar, bass guitar and vocals – supplying all necessary equipment.

Each two hour session is comprised of one hour of tuition with a professional tutor in each instrument, and an hour of group play and practice.

Students benefit from learning an instrument, learning to play contemporary music, learning to play that instrument in a band and gaining confidence in performing in front of others.

## Venue Benefits

In collaboration with the school we can augment the extra-curricular activities that the school can offer.

The venue can benefit from the fees that The Rock Project will pay for the venue hire, 39 weeks a year (thousands of pounds each year).

Rock Project sessions can be attractive to students who may not participate in other after-school clubs.

Junior Sessions introduce younger students to the school.

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
